

## Latest asylum trends

# 1. Number of applicants for international protection in Member States and Associate Countries



In December 2013, the total number of asylum applicants in the Member States and Associate Countries (EU+), decreased approximately 13% compared to November 2013. However, compared to the same month of the previous year the number of total applicants in 2013 was 24% higher than the number of applicants registered in December 2012. The total number of asylum applications made in the EU+ countries, during the year of 2013 appears likely to have exceeded 450,000.

### 2. Top countries of origin (% of total claims) in EU+ countries



Nationals coming from Western Balkans countries continued to represent the largest proportion of asylum applicants in the EU+ countries in the first ten months of 2013.

#### 3. Latest country of origin trends

#### Syria

- In December 2013, Syrian applicants were in the top 3 countries of origin in 16 Member States and Associated Countries, representing the most widespread caseload of asylum applications across EU+ countries:
- However, following the seasonal trend, the number of Syrians decreased in almost all MSAC compared to previous months;

#### **Eritrea**

• After a strong increase during the summer, Eritrean applicants continued to represent an important flow for EU+ countries in the last months of 2013 at a higher level compared to the first half of 2013;

#### Western Balkans

- In December 2013, the number of total Western Balkans asylum applicants in the EU+ was 17% of the total applicants in EU+ countries though there was a 17% decrease in numbers of applicants registered in December compared to November;
- Germany continued to receive the vast majority of applications from Western Balkans citizens.
